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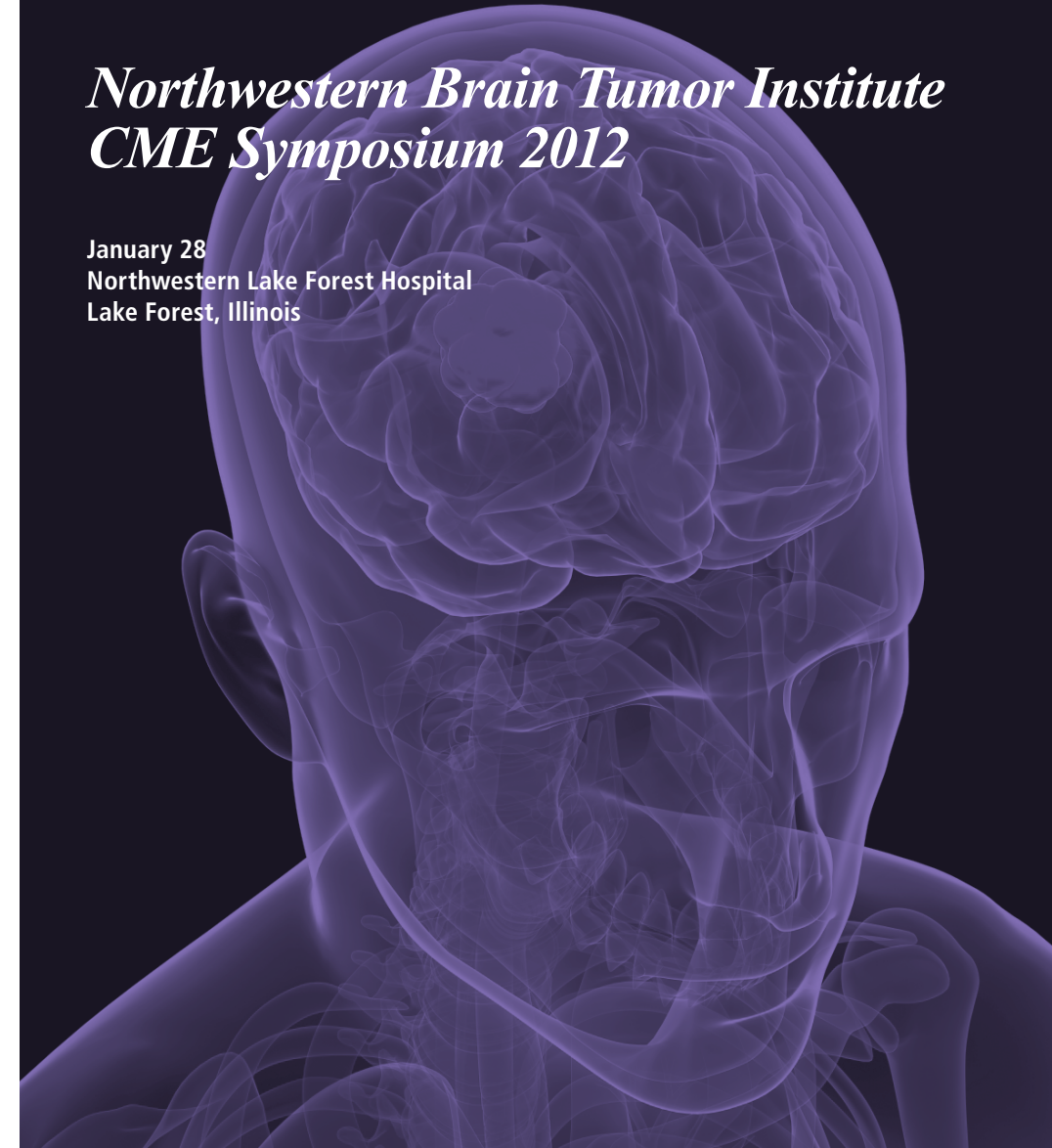

The symposium will present an up-to-date review of current treatments (Neurosurgery, Radiation Therapy and Chemotherapy) for malignant gliomas and newer areas of research within neuro-oncology occurring in clinical trials (including many trials being performed through the Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Cancer Center of Northwestern University.) In the past few years, there have been exciting technical and technological advances in surgical and radiation therapy and newly FDA-approved drugs for the treatment of brain tumor patients. This data will be discussed in dedicated lecture formats. This educational program is focused toward healthcare professionals involved in the care of patients with brain tumors. There will be time at the end of the lectures for participants to present cases for discussion.
