

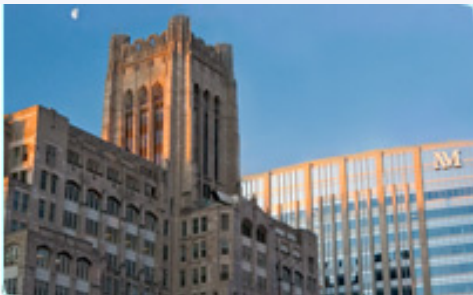

Why should you enroll in the SPORE?

It's simple.

Participants with a history of or at risk for developing prostate cancer will be asked to provide biological specimens and data and may be contacted annually by study staff.



It's convenient.

There is no cost to participate and there are no extra hospital visits. Follow-up information may be collected from medical records, a brief phone call, or an online questionnaire.

It's confidential.

Information collected from you or your medical records will be kept confidential. Specimens will be identified by code, not by name.

It's your contribution.

The biological specimens and health information we collect from you will help researchers increase knowledge of prostate cancer.
